Eligibility:

1. Graduating seniors in good academic standing from any accredited high school (public or private) or home school may submit an entry.
2. Applicants must be related to a member of the Moon-McGehee Chapter of DRT or members of the Burleson-Milam II Chapter of CRT.
3. Applicants must have been accepted by, or applied to an accredited university, college, or vocational/technical school. NOTE: The scholarship will be awarded when the winner provides proof of enrollment.
4. Applicants must be citizens of the United States.

Instructions:

1. Each student must complete and submit an application form.
2. Each student must submit a letter of recommendation from a counselor, vice-principal, principal or appropriate school official. Alternatively, a letter from a community leader that knows you well can be used. The letter should attest to the student's good academic standing as well as why the writer believes you should be considered for the scholarship prize.
3. Submit a Curriculum Vitae highlighting student activities and academic achievements.
4. Submit a recent high school transcript.
